#### Message from the Grand Chaplain

Rev. Agnel Jose De Heredia #32, GC, welcomed everyone to the Grand Council Session and how nice it was to be together once again. He focused his discussion on Pope Leo 14<sup>th</sup>, the first American to become Pope and the importance of Fathers to their children And their families.

Highlights of his presentation follow:

- How elections for Popes take place
- Social media take on who were the front runners to be elected to the Papacy
- Cardinal Robert Provost, became a cardinal in 2024 and was given a new position
- Appointed by Pope Francis as Prefect of Dicastery for Bishops in 2023
- 249 serving Cardinals of which 131 were eligible to vote at the conclave
- Cardinals under the age of 80 years of age can participate in the conclave
- Cardinal Prevost became Pope after four rounds of voting and chose Leo as his name
  to honor Pope Leo XIII. It possibly was a signal of his commitment to strong
  leadership, social justice issues, and a focus on prayer and family
- The important role that Fathers play in their families especially to their children
- Parish make Fathers' Day special within their parish
- Fathers are not perfect but are loved by their children and families
- Happy Father's Day to all the fathers

# **Preliminary Budget Report**

Bob Bartoli #32, GT, presented the proposed Grand Council Operating Budget for 2025-2026 as printed in the Advanced Proceedings on pages 45-46. He advised of the following regarding the proposed 2025 - 2026 budget:

- The budgeted expense amount for the Grand Secretary and Grand Treasurer were reduced by \$1000.00 each
- The telecommunication expense was reduced quite a bit
- Insurance cost eff: 6/18/25: \$12,883.00
- The YMI is not taking in enough funds to pay for our insurance cost
- Per Capita tax next year
- Death benefits paid out last YMI year: \$92,500.00
- Roughly 40 members pass away each year  $(40 \times \$2,500.00 = \text{'s }\$100,000.00)$
- Met with both stockbrokers A few adjustments were made. Below are the current balances:
