Newsletter for Septembergy, 2023

<u>Our last meeting</u>, Pres. Alex Preciado, 1st. Vice Stan Martinez, 2hd Vice Rich O'Brien, Treasurer John Diaz, Fr. Gobbo, exec. Committee: Chuck Gullo, Lewis Borg, were present. Marshall Larry Gallegos excused. Also, four members attended. Special quests: Grand President Steve Cresci, Grand Council Business manager Tom Fourie, Grand 2nd Vice William Walls, Board of Directors member Alex Schmitt were present too.

Treasurer John Diaz first read vouchers for payment prior to handling them over to the Executive Committee for review and approval. Next, a financial statement on Council #2 August checking account disbursements and receipts were passed out to the members and read. The report indicated we had total deposits of \$20,000.17 and total of disbursements of \$11,876.67. End of the balance was \$\$22,102.40. Merrill Lynch investments at the end of August was \$652,164.75. Combined checking and investments accounts totaled \$674,267.15. Executive read and approved vouchers for payment. A motion was presented to pay the bills and a second was in agreement to pay the bills. Council approved to pay the bills.

Received from the Grand Council the form for the essay contest to disburse to the members. Also raffle tickets for the Red and White Mass in March 2024. Informed the council it is a worthy cause and fund raiser. Most of the members stated that they received their packet in the mail. Informed the council I had extra forms if they needed more.

I informed the council that our Treasurer John Diaz is moving out of the area— Roseville, CA. He will no longer be our treasurer. I presented this to our
