Session in June voted to increase our Liability Insurance Assessment by \$4.00 for the 2025-2026 year. In addition, there is a previously scheduled \$6.00 increase in the Per Capita Tax for next year. Our current dues are \$60.00 per year.

A motion was made at our July Business meeting to increase YMI Council #32 annual dues to \$75.00 per member per year. The motion passed unanimously with an effective date of
