Jim Calabretta Essay Contest: As reported in the last newsletter, we received 73 essays for the 20th Annual Essay Contest! The essay breakdown by division is as follows:

- College: 10 entries (We pay the top ten, so all contestants will win a prize!)
- High School: 23 entries (We pay top fifteen contestants.)
- Elementary: 40 entries (We pay top twenty-five)

This year's essay contest will have the largest prize fund ever at \$21,000.
