Jim Calabretta YMI #613 Essay Contest: The 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Jim Calabretta Essay Contest received 77 essay submissions from students attending middle school (35 received for 25 prizes), high school (25 received for 15 prizes) and college (17 received for 10 prizes). The essays have been distributed to the judges to be scored and we expect to be inviting high-scoring contestants to an awards ceremony in February. This year's essay contest boasts a combined prize fund of \$21,000 for 50 talented students and the award ceremony is scheduled for Saturday March 23<sup>rd</sup> in St. Cecilia's Lower Church.
