I will try to keep my remarks brief, but I think it's important that we reflect on all the good work we did this year while working together successfully.

- First, in 2023, YMI #613 enjoyed an **outstanding** year for **New Membership** as we <u>initiated 16 new Brothers!</u> I don't recall us <u>ever</u> having such a productive year for membership and as a result, our current membership roster has peaked to **114 members!** For sponsoring most of these 16 new Brothers, please let us acknowledge **Br. Cosmo Amato, Br. Dominic Panina, Br. Mario Balistreri and Br. Dennis Aicardi.**
- YMI #613's **Finances** remained healthy in 2023, largely through the astute investing by our Investment Committee. Please let us recognize our Investment Committee Reps: **Br. John Cleary, Br. John Kavanagh, and Br. Paul Wuerstle**.
- YMI #613 Events did quite well in 2023. Besides hosting successful events such as Ladies Night, the Summer Picnic, the Italian Heritage Parade, and the Hour of Memory, we effectively managed to revive the YMI Bocce Ball Tourney in 2023 after a 3-year hiatus due to COVID. Let us take a moment to thank the Event Chairs or co-Chairs: Br. Bob Fiorito, Br. Joe Soracco, Br. Cosmo Amato, Br. Mario Balistrieri. and Br. Mike Dimech.
- Regarding the afore mentioned Italian Heritage Parade, please let me add two highlights:
 - 1. Our parade entry of gorgeous classic cars this year earned a respectable 3rd Place Award in the Antique/Classic Car Division.
 - 2. The YMI proudly sponsored the 2023 Queen Isabella Court and its Queen, and our very own **Mia Soracco.**
- In 2023, YMI #613 maintained its generous goodwill programs. Namely, we:
 - awarded over \$21,000 in essay contest awards to 50 students in our 20th Annual Jim Calabretta
 Essay Contest! Let us recognize Br. John Kavanagh (please stand) for his good work running our
 contest.
 - o provided another **\$8,000** in scholarships to eight 8th graders in San Francisco who will be attending Catholic High Schools!
 - o contributed over **\$7,000** in donations to many worthy non-profits helping church organizations, youth groups, our military, the sick, or those in need.
 - lastly, we continued to collect canned food & toiletries at YMI #613 meetings and events on behalf of the San Bruno Catholic Workers Hospitality House. Tonight ---thanks to your generosity--we have plenty more to help those in need!
- In 2023, YMI #613 sponsored **9 seminarians** through the YMI Seminarian Education Foundation. Thanks largely to the efforts of Br. Cosmo, 9 seminarians from Salesian and St. Patrick's Seminaries received scholarship awards totaling **\$5700!**
- For the 2023 Pro Patria Raffle, YMI #613, once again, was among the leaders in ticket sales with a 30% participation level of it YMI Brothers. And I am hearing we're off to a decent start for 2024 with about 21% of YMI #613 Brothers already buying tickets. (Please buy raffle tickets if you haven't already! If you can't find them, let Br. - Finally, for the most recent Grand Council Pro Patria Essay Contest, YMI #613 again had a major impact, sponsoring the 1st place winner (**Br. Brian Blake's son Matt**) and **5 of the 15 contest winners** in the High School Division for **over \$3400** in **contest prizes!**

In looking back over these many achievements and doing some math, I estimate we have collectively given or enabled to be given over \$50,000 in 2023! Folks, we deserve a HUGE round of applause for all the goodwill we do! As 2024 approaches, I am confident that we will continue our good work.
