2025 Christmas Party Remarks of Br. Mike Amato

Ladies and Brothers....As the Christmas Party co-chair with Br. George Totah, let me begin my remarks by thanking each of you for attending our Christmas Party. The 85 people here tonight marks one of our largest Christmas Party turnouts that I can recall since chairing this event. We are truly grateful that you have joined us this evening to celebrate Christmas together!

As has become our tradition for many years now, this is the time when I report on YMI St. John Bosco Council #613's many accomplishments. I will try to keep my remarks brief as we have a phenomenal raffle coming up, but I believe it is important for us to take a few moments and reflect with on our successes this year!

- First, YMI #613 **initiated 5 new YMI Brothers in 2025!** While many YMI Councils are losing YMI Brothers, we are maintaining a membership base of 113 members and are now **the 4th largest YMI Council!**
- YMI #613's **Finances** have reached **all-time highs** thanks to a surging stock market and the astute investing skill of our Investment Committee! I'll spare you specific numbers here but let us recognize the solid efforts of our Investment Committee: **Br. John Cleary, Br. John Kavanagh, and Br. Paul Wuerstle .**
- YMI #613 **Social Events** did quite well again in 2025, as we successfully hosted several events such as Ladies Night, the Summer Picnic, the Italian Heritage Parade, the Bocce Ball Tourney, the Hour of Memory, and our Christmas Party. Let us take a moment to thank the great work of our Event Chairs, co-Chairs, and Assistant Chairs: **Br. Bob Fiorito, Br. Joe Soracco, Br. Mike Dimech, Br. Mario Balistreri, Br. Cosmo Amato, Br. George Totah and myself.**
- Most significantly for 2025, YMI #613 expanded its generous **goodwill programs**. Namely, :
 - **We awarded over \$21,000** in essay contest awards to 50 students who participated in our **22nd Annual "Jim Calabretta Essay Contest"**! Let us recognize **Br. John Kavanagh** for his terrific work running our essay contest.
 - We provided a record high **\$16,000 in scholarships** through our Council's newly re-named **"Cosmo Amato Scholarship" program** to eight 8th graders from four different parish grammar schools who will be attending Catholic High Schools! Let us recognize **Br. Cosmo** for his passion in supporting our scholarship program
 - We contributed over **\$15,500 in cash donations** during the year benefitting Catholic churches, seminaries, religious orders, and worthy non-profits helping our youth, our military, the sick, the disabled, & those in need.
 - We collected a huge number of canned food & toiletries at YMI #613 meetings and social events and distributed them to the San Bruno Catholic Workers Hospitality House (I would estimate at least **over \$1500 worth**). Tonight ---thanks to your Christmas Spirit, we have plenty more goods to help those in need!
 - YMI #613 sponsored **7 seminarians** this year from the Salesian and St. Patrick's Seminaries through the **YMI Seminarian Education Foundation**, for scholarship awards totaling **approximately \$4000!**
 - For the **2025 Pro Patria Raffle**, YMI #613, once again, was among the YMI leaders in ticket sales contributing over a \$1000 in support with a reported **24% participation level**.
 - Finally, for the **2025 Grand Council Pro Patria Essay Contest**, YMI #613 sponsored **4 of the 15 contest winners** in the High School Division. Collectively, those students received **\$1100 in contest prizes from the YMI!**

By doing some basic math here on these many efforts, I estimate we are responsible for **well over \$60,000 in goodwill projects during 2025!** Folks, we deserve a **HUGE** round of applause for all this goodwill we do as a YMI Council!

Looking ahead to 2026, YMI #613 will be expanding our impressive goodwill efforts. At our recent meeting last week, we voted:

- **to increase** our Cosmo Amato Scholarship Program from **\$16,000 to \$30,000**, which will mean the award of **10 scholarships awards at \$3000 each!**
- **to increase** our mandated annual donations by \$3,000 to **over \$11,000** by including two new charities and giving more to our current supported churches.

In addition for 2026, we will be taking the leadership role of two YMI Grand Council events:

- On February 14th, **Br. Mike Dimech and Br. Steve Cresci #32** are organizing a **YMI Pasta Bingo Fundraiser** at St. Cecilia's.
- On March 14th, **Br. Mario Balistreri** is handling the annual **YMI Red & White Mass**. Also at St. Cecilia's.

We hope to see you attend these two YMI events, as well as regular YMI #613 events held next year.

Let me conclude here by thanking you **AGAIN** for all you did this past year, as well as offering my sincere wish that you **ALL** enjoy a **Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!**
